The Pedagogical Beliefs of Queensland Teachers

Teachers' mathematical teaching practices are strongly influenced by their beliefs about mathematics and its teaching and learning. These teaching practices then influence how their students view mathematics and their ability to do mathematics This session will present findings from a recent survey of Queensland teachers' mathematical beliefs and identify consistency between their beliefs and pedagogical practices.
